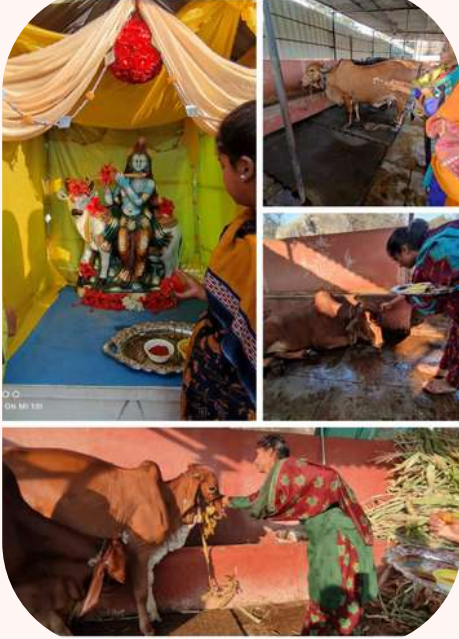


## Mahaganapati Homam

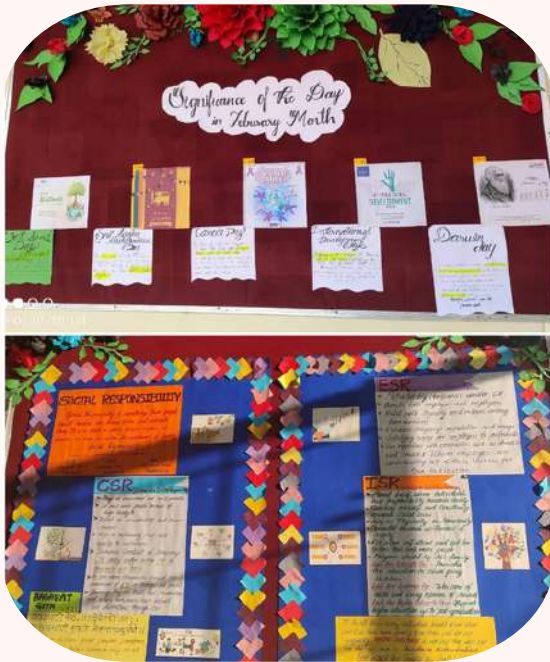


# CSR Meeting with Sadguru
